O Yahweh, our Lord, How majestic is Your name in all the earth, Who have displayed Your splendor above the heavens! 8:2 From the mouth of infants and nursing babes You have established strength. The birds of the heavens, and the fish of the sea, 8:8 Whatever passes through the paths of the seas. 8:9 O Yahweh, our Lord, How majestic is Your name in all the earth! 19:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David.) The heavens are telling of the glory of God; And their expanse is declaring the work of His hands. 19:2 Day to day pours forth speech, And night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words; 19:3 Their voice is not heard. 19:4 Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their utterances to the end of the world. In them He has placed a tent for the sun, 19:5 Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber; It rejoices as a strong man to run his course. - 33:6 By the word of Yahweh the heavens were made, And by the breath of His mouth all their host.
- 33:7 He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deeps in storehouses.
- 33:8 Let all the earth fear Yahweh; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.
- 33:9 For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.
- 33:10 Yahweh nullifies the counsel of the nations; He frustrates the plans of the peoples.
- 33:11 The counsel of Yahweh stands forever, The plans of His heart from generation to generation.
- 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is Yahweh, The people whom He has chosen for His own inheritance.
- 33:13 Yahweh looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men;
- 33:14 From His dwelling place He looks out On all the inhabitants of the earth,
- 33:15 He who fashions the hearts of them all, He who understands all their works.
- 65:1 (For the choir director. A Psalm of David. A Song.) There will be silence before You, and praise in Zion, O God; And to You the vow will be performed.
- 65:2 O You who do hear prayer, To You all men come.
- 65:3 Iniquities prevail against me;
 As for our transgressions, You forgive them.
 65:4 How blessed is the one whom You choose, and br
- 65:4 How blessed is the one whom You choose, and bring near to You, To dwell in Your courts.We will be satisfied with the goodness of Your house, Your holy temple.
- 65:5 By awesome deeds You answer us in righteousness, O God of our salvation, You who are the trust of all the ends of the earth and of the farthest sea;
- 65:6 Who do establish the mountains by His strength, Being girded with might;
- 65:7 Who do still the roaring of the seas, The roaring of their waves, And the tumult of the peoples.
- 65:8 And they who dwell in the ends of the earth stand in awe of Your signs; You make the dawn and the sunset shout for joy.
- 65:9 You visit the earth, and cause it to overflow; You greatly enrich it; The stream of God is full of water; You prepare their grain, for thus You prepare the earth.

- 65:10 You water its furrows abundantly; You settle its ridges; You soften it with showers; You bless its growth.
- 65:11 You have crowned the year with Your bounty, And Your paths drip with fatness.
- 65:12 The pastures of the wilderness drip, And the hills gird themselves with rejoicing.
- 65:13 The meadows are clothed with flocks, And the valleys are covered with grain; They shout for joy, yes, they sing.
- 75:2 "When I select an appointed time, It is I who judge with equity.
- 75:3 "The earth and all who dwell in it melt; It is I who have firmly set its pillars. Selah.
- 90:1 (A Prayer of Moses the man of God.) Lord, You have been our dwelling place in all generations.
- 90:2 Before the mountains were born, Or You gave birth to the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.
- 90:3 You turn man back into dust, And do say, "Return, O children of men."
- 90:4 For a thousand years in Your sight Are like yesterday when it passes by, Or as a watch in the night.
- 93:1 Yahweh reigns, He is clothed with majesty; Yahweh has clothed and girded Himself with strength; Indeed, the world is firmly established, it will not be moved.
- 93:2 Your throne is established from of old; You are from everlasting.
- 93:3 The floods have lifted up, O Yahweh, The floods have lifted up their voice; The floods lift up their pounding waves.
- 93:4 More than the sounds of many waters, Than the mighty breakers of the sea, Yahweh on high is mighty.
- 93:5 Your testimonies are fully confirmed; Holiness befits Your house, O Yahweh, forevermore.
- 95:1 O come, let us sing for joy to Yahweh; Let us shout joyfully to the rock of our salvation.
- 95:2 Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.

95:3 For Yahweh is a great God, And a great King above all gods,

- 95:4 In whose hand are the depths of the earth; The peaks of the mountains are His also.
- 95:5 The sea is His, for it was He who made it; And His hands formed the dry land.
- 104:1 Bless Yahweh, O my soul! O Yahweh my God, You are very great; You are clothed with splendor and majesty,
- 104:2 Covering Yourself with light as with a cloak, Stretching out heaven like a tent curtain.
- 104:3 He lays the beams of His upper chambers in the waters; He makes the clouds His chariot; He walks upon the wings of the wind;
- 104:4 He makes the winds His messengers, Flaming fire His ministers.
- 104:5 He established the earth upon its foundations, So that it will not totter forever and ever.
- 104:6 You covered it with the deep as with a garment; The waters were standing above the mountains.
- 104:7 At Your rebuke they fled; At the sound of Your thunder they hurried away.
- 104:8 The mountains rose; the valleys sank down To the place which You established for them.
- 104:9 You set a boundary that they may not pass over; That they may not return to cover the earth.
- 104:10 He sends forth springs in the valleys; They flow between the mountains;
- 104:11 They give drink to every beast of the field; The wild donkeys quench their thirst.
- 104:12 Beside them the birds of the heavens dwell; They lift up their voices among the branches.
- 104:13 He waters the mountains from His upper chambers; The earth is satisfied with the fruit of His works.
- 104:14 He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, And vegetation for the labor of man, So that he may bring forth food from the earth,
- 104:15 And wine which makes man's heart glad, So that he may make his face glisten with oil, And food which sustains man's heart.
- 104:16 The trees of Yahweh drink their fill, The cedars of Lebanon which He planted,
- 104:17 Where the birds build their nests, And the stork, whose home is the fir trees.
- 104:18 The high mountains are for the wild goats; The cliffs are a refuge for the rock badgers.

- 104:19 He made the moon for the seasons;
 - The sun knows the place of its setting.
- 104:20 You appoint darkness and it becomes night, In which all the beasts of the forest prowl about.
- 104:21 The young lions roar after their prey, And seek their food from God.
- 104:22 When the sun rises they withdraw, And lie down in their dens.
- 104:23 Man goes forth to his work And to his labor until evening.
- 104:24 O Yahweh, how many are Your works! In wisdom You have made them all; The earth is full of Your possessions.
- 104:25 There is the sea, great and broad, In which are swarms without number, Animals both small and great.
- 104:26 There the ships move along, And Leviathan, which You have formed to sport in it.
- 104:27 They all wait for You,
 - To give them their food in due season.
- 104:28 You give to them, they gather it up;
 - You open Your hand, they are satisfied with good.
- 104:29 You hide Your face, they are dismayed; You take away their spirit, they expire, And return to their dust.
- 104:30 You send forth Your Spirit, they are created;
 - And You renew the face of the ground.
- 104:31 Let the glory of Yahweh endure forever; Let Yahweh be glad in His works;
- 104:32 He looks at the earth, and it trembles; He touches the mountains, and they smoke.
- 104:33 I will sing to Yahweh as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.
- 104:34 Let my meditation be pleasing to Him; As for me, I shall be glad in Yahweh.
- 104:35 Let sinners be consumed from the earth, And let the wicked be no more. Bless Yahweh, O my soul.
 - Praise Yahweh!
- 107:23 Those who go down to the sea in ships, Who do business on great waters;
- 107:24 They have seen the works of Yahweh, And His wonders in the deep.
- 107:25 For He spoke and raised up a stormy wind, Which lifted up the waves of the sea.

- 107:26 They rose up to the heavens, they went down to the depths; Their soul melted away in their misery.
- 107:27 They reeled and staggered like a drunken man, And were at their wits' end.
- 107:28 Then they cried to Yahweh in their trouble, And He brought them out of their distresses.
- 107:29 He caused the storm to be still,

So that the waves of the sea were hushed.

- 107:30 Then they were glad because they were quiet; So He guided them to their desired haven.
- 139:13 For You formed my inward parts; You wove me in my mother's womb.
- 139:14 I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well.
- 139:15 My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skillfully wrought in the depths of the earth.
- 139:16 Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in Your book they were all written, The days that were ordained for me, When as yet there was not one of them.
- 147:1 Praise Yahweh! For it is good to sing praises to our God; For it is pleasant and praise is becoming.
- 147:2 Yahweh builds up Jerusalem; He gathers the outcasts of Israel.
- 147:3 He heals the brokenhearted, And binds up their wounds.
- 147:4 He counts the number of the stars; He gives names to all of them.
- 147:5 Great is our Lord, and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite.
- 147:6 Yahweh supports the afflicted; He brings down the wicked to the ground.
- 147:7 Sing to Yahweh with thanksgiving; Sing praises to our God on the lyre,
- 147:8 Who covers the heavens with clouds, Who provides rain for the earth, Who makes grass to grow on the mountains.
- 147:9 He gives to the beast its food,
- And to the young ravens which cry.
- 147:10 He does not delight in the strength of the horse; He does not take pleasure in the legs of a man.
- 147:11 Yahweh favors those who fear Him,

Those who wait for His lovingkindness.

- 147:12 Praise Yahweh, O Jerusalem!
 - Praise your God, O Zion!
- 147:13 For He has strengthened the bars of your gates; He has blessed your sons within you.
- 147:14 He makes peace in your borders; He satisfies you with the finest of the wheat.
- 147:15 He sends forth His command to the earth; His word runs very swiftly.
- 147:16 He gives snow like wool; He scatters the frost like ashes.
- 147:17 He casts forth His ice as fragments; Who can stand before His cold?
- 147:18 He sends forth His word and melts them; He causes His wind to blow and the waters to flow.
- 147:19 He declares His words to Jacob, His statutes and His ordinances to Israel.
- 147:20 He has not dealt thus with any nation; And as for His ordinances, they have not known them. Praise Yahweh!
- 148:1 Praise Yahweh! Praise Yahweh from the heavens; Praise Him in the heights!
- 148:2 Praise Him, all His angels; Praise Him, all His hosts!
- 148:3 Praise Him, sun and moon; Praise Him, all stars of light!
- 148:4 Praise Him, highest heavens, And the waters that are above the heavens!
- 148:5 Let them praise the name of Yahweh, For He commanded and they were created.
- 148:6 He has also established them forever and ever; He has made a decree which will not pass away.
- 148:7 Praise Yahweh from the earth, Sea monsters and all deeps;
- 148:8 Fire and hail, snow and clouds; Stormy wind, fulfilling His word;
- 148:9 Mountains and all hills; Fruit trees and all cedars;
- 148:10 Beasts and all cattle; Creeping things and winged fowl;
- 148:11 Kings of the earth and all peoples; Princes and all judges of the earth;
- 148:12 Both young men and virgins; Old men and children.
- 148:13 Let them praise the name of Yahweh,
 - For His name alone is exalted;

His glory is above earth and heaven. And He has lifted up a horn for His people, Praise for all His godly ones; 148:14 Even for the sons of Israel, a people near to Him. Praise Yahweh!
